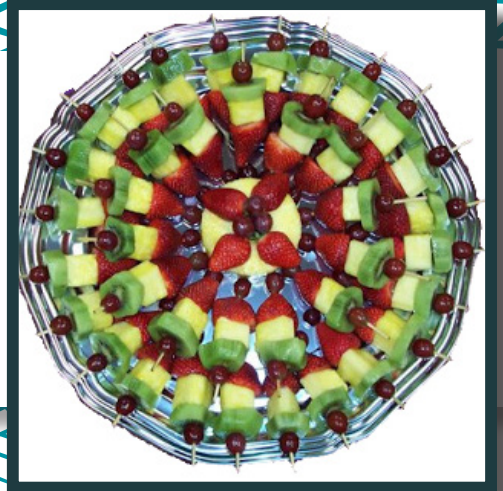




NEW YEAR'S TRADITIONS

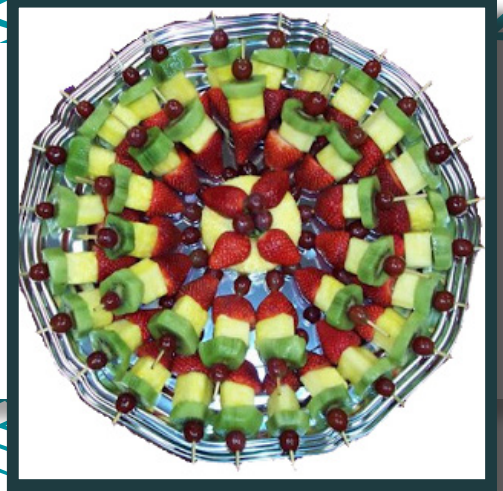


Did you know?
