

# MAKEUP BRUSHES

## Mineral Makeup

### A. Eyeliner Brush

**What it is for:** Eyes and brows.

**How to use it:** Wet bristles and tap off excess water into a tissue. Dip into mineral and press into lid. Tap off excess. Line eyes as needed.



### B. Crease Brush

**What it is for:** A brush that precisely applies and blends shadow into the creases to add depth.

**How to use it:** Make your eyes pop with this brush specially designed to add dramatic definition. Use the tapered tip along the crease of the eye to softly blend shadow and make eyes appear larger. The soft fibers form a medium, dome shape and promise supple, smooth application.



### C. Eyeshadow Brush

**What it is for:** Apply all over eyeshadow, dry or wet.

**How to use it:** Dip into minerals and tap off excess. Press the brush into corner of the eye and sweep out across lid.



### D. Concealer Brush

**What it is for:** Apply concealer and blend. The shape works well for application for contouring and blending. Try not to use your hand on anything on your face.

**How to use:** Load brush with yellow concealer. Dab on areas and lightly feather to a soft blend.



### E. Angled Blush Brush

**What it is for:** precise mineral blush application. Can be used with a bronzer for contouring also.

**How to use it:** Dip in mineral blush and tap off excess. At the cheek bone beginning at the apple of your cheek, use small swirls and sweep up and out towards your hairline.



### F. Large Powder Brush

**What it is for:** Apply Mineral Powder all over and works great on neck and décolletage. Excellent for bronzing powder you do not want to buff into the skin. Also works for Mineral Veil application.

**How to use it:** Dip into powder, bronzer, or Mineral Veil and tap off excess. Begin at forehead and use sweeping brush strokes all over face, jaw line, neck, and décolletage.



### G. Kabuki Brush

**What it is for:** Can you say air brush finish? Applying mineral makeup, blush, and bronzers.

**How to use it:** Dip into powder and tap off excess. Apply all over face in a circular buffing motion beginning at the forehead so if any loose minerals fall on your face you will be buffing them into your face anyway.
